# This Month in 1989

## General Plan Creation

With Diamond Bar's incorporation made official during the first City Council meeting on Tuesday, April 18, 1989 at Chaparral Middle School, the month of May saw City Council members continue efforts to start up the new city government. These efforts included embarking on the creation of the State-mandated general plan to guide all future land use planning activities for the city. As an initial step, the Diamond Bar Council held its first special study session on May 9, 1989 at the Walnut Valley Unified School District. Items discussed included the creation of a planning commission, the hiring of a city planner, and the status of the current community plan.

# Bow-wow Bash @ Pantera Bark Park

## DB dogs are in for a treat on May 31

Every dog has its day – and for those who call Diamond Bar home, the day is Saturday, May 31. That's when the City is holding a special event just for them as part of its year-long celebration commemorating the City's 25 years of cityhood.

Bow-wow Bash will be held at Bark Park @ Pantera Park, 738 Pantera Drive, from 10 am to 2 pm and feature fun activities for dogs and their owners, as well as giveaways.

Bark Park, which opened in November 2012, is located on a 1.35-acre site on the south side of Pantera Park near the basketball courts. It comprises two enclosed areas where dogs can play and socialize leash-free, with amenities that include drinking fountains with pet bowls, doggie waste bags, trash receptacles, park benches, and shade structures. ## Click it or Ticket Mobilization

The Diamond Bar/Walnut Sheriff's Station, along with other law enforcement agencies nationwide, is stepping up seatbelt enforcement as part of the 2014 Click It or Ticket mobilization.

The mobilization, which starts May 19 and runs until June 1, is a high-visibility enforcement effort created by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to crack down on seatbelt violators.

According to NHTSA data, fatalities are up nationwide for the first time in 5 years. In 2012, 10,335 people who were killed in motor vehicle crashes were not wearing their seat belts.

NHTSA reports also indicate that more traffic vehicle deaths occur during the nighttime hours of 6 pm and 6 am, and that more than half of the passenger occupants killed were not wearing their seatbelts. As a result, nighttime enforcement will continue to be a priority in this year's mobilization.

Under current State law, drivers are responsible for seat belt compliance for all passengers. If the seat belt violator is over 16 years of age, both the driver and the passenger can be cited separately. Offenses may also result in points to the violator's driving record, which could raise insurance rates.

Workshop attendees will also have the opportunity to purchase discounted backyard (\$40 each) or worm composting bin (\$65 each).



## Do your part to prevent vegetation from turning into kindling

Hillside property owners are reminded that the Los Angeles County Fire Department has begun conducting its annual brush clearance inspections.

The inspections are part of the Fire Department's efforts to protect properties from the threat of wildfire, and include fire personnel canvassing the city and issuing 30-day correction notices to residents whose property does not comply with the County's Brush Clearance requirements.

These requirements, aimed at creating defensible space in which firefighters can operate safely in order to help protect a home during a wildfire, are the legal responsibility of homeowners and include the following:

Removing all flammable vegetation or other combustible growth within 30 feet (50 feet in areas determined to be high fire hazard) of any structure; and thinning out or remove additional vegetation an additional 70 feet from the structure; an additional 100 feet of thinning or removal may be required in high fire hazard areas.

Additional measures to help safeguard homes from wildfires include:

**Yard:** Landscaping with fire-resistant, low-growing plants with high moisture content; and keeping woodpiles, propane tanks

and combustible materials away from the house and other structures, such as garages and sheds.

**Roof:** Clearing pine needles, leaves, and other debris from the roof and gutters; screening or enclosing rain gutters to prevent accumulation of plant debris; and cutting any tree branches within 10 feet of the roof.

**Vents:** Covering all vent openings with 1/8 inch or smaller metal mesh; do not use fiberglass or plastic mesh because it can melt and burn.

**Windows:** Installing dual-paned with the exterior pane of tempered glass windows to reduce the chance of breakage in a fire.

**Water Supplies:** Having multiple garden hoses long enough to reach any area of the house and other structures on your property is strongly recommended; swimming pools or other bodies of water can also become a source of firefighting water when a portable pump is added.

## Wildlife Reminders

### Be prepared for increased interactions with wildlife

Visiting or living near open space areas means occasional encounters with wildlife, particularly during spring and summer when sightings increase due to breeding and migrating activity.

For the most part, wildlife-watching is an enjoyable experience if done from a safe and respectable distance. Issues arise when these animals, particularly those of a predator nature such as coyotes, lose their natural fear of humans. It is when coyotes become habituated to people that the potential for conflict occurs, making small house pets vulnerable and susceptible to predation.

To prevent your property from attracting coyotes, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife recommends the following dos and don'ts:

- Do trim shrubs in and around your property to prevent cover for dens
- Do pick up fallen fruit and maintain fruit-bearing trees
- Do prevent access to garbage cans and cover compost piles
- Do bring outdoor pets indoors for the evening, or house them in a secure enclosure
- Don't feed or attempt to tame coyotes
- Don't leave small pets unattended or unleashed

If you cross paths with a coyote and it begins to follow you or exhibit aggressive behavior, call 9-1-1. Also, do not turn your back and run as this might trigger the coyote's instinct to chase; instead stand as tall as possible, waive your arms, and make loud noises. If the coyote does not leave, throw rocks, sticks, or other objects in its direction.

Coyotes are members of the dog family and closely resemble a small German Shepherd with the exception of the long snout and bushy tail. They are attracted to places that provide shelter (cover) and easy pickings of food (pet food, fruit, or small animals).

## FAQ's

**Can my children play together on the same team?**  
 Siblings who live in the same household and play in the same age division will always be placed on the same team. Children are allowed to "play-up" one division (play in a division above their age group), however they are not allowed to play-down.

**May I request that my child be placed with the same coach as last year? Or on the same team as a friend?**

Requests are taken at registration, but are not guaranteed. During the player draft, coaches will be notified of all requests. 


