## Heritage Park & Community Center Improvement Project: Your Input is Wanted

Heritage Park, one of the city's oldest community park, is set to be the beneficiary of extensive, site-wide renovations this coming year. A public workshop held on Thursday, November 13, 2014 officially kicked off the public input process with many other opportunities for public dialogue and community feedback planned for the community months.

Located at 2900 S. Brea Canyon Road, Heritage Park is a heavily-used facility serving both neighborhood and community park purposes in one of the more densely populated areas of the city. The park covers 3.4 acres and currently comprises a lighted softball field, tot lots, picnic areas, and a community building that remains unchanged since it opened in 1993 and a restroom facility that is in its original form since constructed in 1986.

The bulk of the proposed renovations will focus on improving the look and function of the community center by updating its interior design, equipping it with modern technology, installing energy-efficient features and constructing new restroom facilities. Other improvements include making ADA accessibility upgrades throughout the park site, replacing the tot lot equipment and rubber surfacing, and additional picnic tables with barbecues.

# Guarding Against Holiday Burglaries

With FBI statistics showing that the holiday season is a peak time for burglaries, the Diamond Bar Sheriff's team urges residents to be on extra alert and take proper measures to eliminate opportunities for would-be burglars. Suggested measures include the following:



**Be an alert shopper.** Park in a well-lighted space, lock your doors and windows, and hide shopping bags and other valuables in the trunk.

**Don't advertise what's under your holiday tree.** Do not leave packaging of new electronics and other items outside of your refuse container for several days at a time. If possible, break down the boxes and leave them indoors or inside your garage until the evening before your regularly scheduled pickup.

**Maintain your home in a lived-in condition.** Before heading out for holiday shopping or even a quick errands, turn on the lights and radio or television in some of your rooms.

**If you are going away for the holidays ...** inform a neighbor, arrange for someone to collect your mail, leave a car in the driveway, and contact the Sheriff's Station to register for its free Property Vacation Check.

As a final thought, you know your neighborhood and who and what belongs – and doesn't belong – on your street. Therefore, you and your neighbors are best suited to keep an eye out for unusual or suspicious individuals or activity and report it to the Sheriff's station by calling 909.595.2264 or 9-1-1 if a crime is in progress.

If the information you provide helps Sheriff's deputies identify and arrest an individual or group of people responsible for damaging or destroying property while attempting or executing a residential or vehicular burglary, you will be eligible to receive a financial reward of up to \$500 as part of the City's Report for Reward program.

## EMERGENCY-READY ...

Taking advantage of October being National Preparedness Month, City staff put their disaster response skills to the test during two drills that included practicing how to safely and properly evacuate City Hall and activating the City's Emergency Response Center (EOC). The drill involving the activation of the



EOC posed a severe earthquake scenario that had City staff responding to such issues as downed power lines, destroyed buildings, damaged roads and inaccurate social media posts and news reports. Another City staff emergency drill simulating a fire is planned for May 2015 when the Los Angeles County fire and sheriff's departments participate in the annual multi-agency Tonner Canyon exercise. Everyone who lives or works in Diamond Bar is encouraged to register with the City's emergency notification system, which is used to alert the community of important information during emergency situations. Individuals have the option to specify their preferred notification method, be it a voice message on a land line, a text to a cell phone, or an email (up to three phone numbers and two email accounts may be registered per individual).

## Free Sandbags

During the rainy weather season, most Los Angeles County fire stations double as free self-serve sandbag stations. If your home is prone to flooding when it rains, stop by local station 119 (20480 Pathfinder Road – 909.598.4290.) or 121 (346 Armitos Road – 909.396.0165) to pick up free sand and sandbags, while supplies last. Don't forget your work gloves and shovels for sandbag filling. A maximum of 25 sandbags will be allowed per household. For more information, call the City's Public Works Department at 909.839.7040.

## End of the Year Collection Service

From gift wrap to disposable dinnerware, the holiday season can sometimes produce more waste than usual. If you are a Waste Management customer, you can take advantage of its free End-of-the-Year collection service to get rid of the excess waste.

For two weeks beginning December 26, Waste Management will be accepting requests for pickups of additional refuse from customers who call 800.266.7551 at least 24 hours before their regularly scheduled collection days.

Please note that material is limited to household waste that belongs but does not fit inside Black Jack. Other waste such as bulky items, hazardous materials and electronics are not eligible for pickup as part of this special service.

The contest called for teens, ages 13 to 18, to write a personal letter to an author whose work changed their way of thinking about the world or themselves.



## Late Night Transit Program Cancelled

Attention, transit pass customers: As a result of two few residents using the City's Transit Late Night service, this program will be discontinued effective January 2015.

Transit Late Night kept City Hall doors open until 7:00 p.m. on the last Tuesday of every month for the in-person purchase of discounted transit tickets and passes.

Diamond Bar residents may continue to take advantage of the City's 20% subsidy on Metrolink train tickets and MTA and Foothill bus passes by stopping by Diamond Bar City Hall during normal operation hours or purchasing the passes anytime online at [transit.DiamondBarCA.gov](http://transit.DiamondBarCA.gov).

Proof of residency in the form of a photo ID or driver's license is required to qualify for the subsidy. Online purchasers must first pre-register in person at City Hall to obtain a user name and password.

City Hall is located at 21810 Copley Drive; operating hours are 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, Monday through Thursday and 7:30 am to 4:30 pm on Friday.

## TOMORROW'S TREASURE ...

More than 120 items representative of the people, places and events of Diamond Bar 2014 were last month tucked into a custom-made, stainless steel time capsule to mark the city's 25 years of incorporation.

Several dozen residents, nonprofit leaders and elected officials attended the official dedication of the time capsule held on Saturday, October 25 at 4:00 p.m. on the first floor of the Diamond Bar City Hall building. Attendees had the opportunity to view the time capsule and images of its contents as well as contribute a written or video-recorded message. The time capsule, which measures 14 x 14 x 30 and weighs approximately 100 pounds, will be mounted this month on a wall on the first floor of the City Hall building and encased with a clear protective cover with instructions for it to be opened in 2039, when Diamond Bar reaches 50 years of cityhood. ### Can my children play together on the same team?





