## Sustainable Gardening

The City is hosting a series of free Smart Gardening Composting workshops during the summer months that will focus on water-wise gardening and drought tolerant plant selection. Residents are invited to participate and learn about plant combinations that require less water and add more color to your garden. Compost bins will be available for purchase at this event at discounted prices. The price for the organic compost bin is \$45, the price for the worm compost bin is \$65. The composting workshops will take place at the Diamond Bar Center Sycamore room, located at 1600 Grand Avenue, during the following dates/times:

## Dispose of HHW and E-Waste the Right Way

Dispose of old paint, batteries, e-waste or motor oil the right way at the next household hazardous waste and E-waste collection event on Saturday, September 12, 2015. This event takes place from 9:00 am-3:00 pm at the John A. Rowland High School located at 2000 South Otterbein Avenue, Rowland Heights. Residents may utilize the mobile, one-day collection event to properly dispose of HHW and electronic waste free of charge.

Examples of items you can bring to the event: computer monitors, televisions, printers, paint, paint thinner, brake fluid, motor oil, oil filters, expired pharmaceuticals, anti-freeze, and fluorescent light bulbs.
