

Ruth Low Mayor Pro Tem



Ruth Low was elected to the City Council in 2015 and is currently serving her first time as Mayor Pro Tem.

Ms. Low served on the City's Planning Commission from 2013 through 2015, and from 2003 through 2005. She served in the position of chairman in 2015 and vice-chairman in 2005.

Prior to that, Ms. Low served on the City's Parks and Recreation Commission from 2005 through 2009, and served as its chairman and vice-chairman.

Ms. Low currently serves as the City Council's delegate to the Wildlife Corridor Conservation Authority and alternate delegate to the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District, Southern California Association of Governments, and the Tres Hermanos Conservation Authority.

Additionally, Ms. Low is the delegate to the City Council's Standing Committees on Legislative issues and alternate delegate on Sphere of Influence/Annexation matters. She is also the Council liaison to the Diamond Bar Community Foundation and alternate liaison to the Diamond Bar Library and the Pomona Unified School District.

Ms. Low is a Deputy District Attorney with the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office. She regularly appears in the Los Angeles County Superior Court and the California Court of Appeals representing the People of the State of California.

She has prosecuted serious and violent crimes such as murder, vehicular manslaughter, robbery, home invasion robbery, burglary, rape, child sexual abuse, mayhem,

domestic violence, assaults, as well as gang related violent crimes. As a member of the Special Prosecution Bureau, she has successfully prosecuted multi-defendant cyber-crimes involving losses in excess of \$1M, large-scale financial fraud cases, major health care frauds, and crimes involving controlled substances and firearms.

In 2011, she was recognized as Outstanding Prosecutor by the FBI for successfully prosecuting complex cases involving state and federal laws.

Ms. Low and her family have lived in Diamond Bar since 1995. She and her husband, Rick Rogers, are active in community activities, most notably co-chairing the Annual Wine Soirée and Benefit Auction. They have been members of the Diamond Bar Friends of the Library for 15 years; Ms. Low served as its President from 2013-2014.
