



## How to Report a Crime or Suspicious Activity

Residents and businesses can contact the Diamond Bar/Walnut Sheriff's Station to report suspicious activity, crime in progress, or life threatening emergency. To report suspicious activity, you can call 909.595.2264. If you witness a crime in progress or life threatening emergency, dial 9-1-1 immediately. The following tips will assist you with reporting a crime or incident:

- Explain the type of crime or incident you are witnessing, and why it looks suspicious.
- State the location of the incident, including exact street address and nearest cross street
- Let the dispatcher know if the event is currently taking place or happened in the past.
- If you see any weapons, state what they appear to be.
- Note how many persons are involved.
- Provide vehicle information, including license number, color, year, make, model, or unique characteristics.
- Recall the suspect(s) information, including race, gender, age, height, weight, hair color, hair length and style, eye color, facial hair, clothing type and color, or other characteristics (e.g., tattoos, missing teeth, scars, glasses), direction of flight, etc.
- Report any injuries.



Contacting the Sheriff's Department to report suspicious activity is encouraged and helps ensure your home and neighborhood are safe. ## Report For Reward

The City of Diamond Bar's Report for Reward program offers individuals a financial incentive of up to \$500 for providing information leading to the arrest of a person(s) who damaged property as a result of a realized or attempted residential or vehicular burglary within the City.
